

Annual Report - 2019

The Annual Report show cases the achievement and glories of our school undoubtedly but also makes us think deeply about our shortcomings. We have always been committed to create an environment in the school which helps the young minds to blossom and provide a platform for individual thinking and holistic development of the child's personality.

As we step into the 33rd year we have around 3200 students on roll who represent different walks of life. Under the RTE Category we have enrolled 12 student in the 2019-20 session and a total of 95 students are on roll.

Our 90 teachers are upgraded continuously and to keep them abreast with the latest trends in teaching the teachers are encouraged to undergo periodical training. Workshop and Capacity Building Programmes have been conducted recently on Integrity and Ethics in school and Inclusion and Inclusive strategies in school. We also have a big team of 35 non teaching staff who work with dedication and sincerity.

I wish to begin with our performance in Academics. Achieving academic excellence is at the heart of our endeavour as educators. We set standards and goals for ourselves and strive to achieve them. In the All India Senior Secondary Exam 2019 a total of 339 students took the exam. The pass % was 94.6%. 18 students secured above 90% and the highest percentage of 94.6% was secured jointly by Kunal Kabra and Rachel Anamika Soreng. Harsh Kumar Singh secured 100% marks in Economics and received the Merit Certificate from CBSE. Hritik Raj was the topper in Commerce securing 94.6%. 77.6% students in Science or 274 students, and 65.7% in Commerce i.e. 41 students secured 1st division marks. While in class X the result was 100% 211 students appeared in the All India Secondary School Examination - 2019. 70 students secured above 90%. The highest aggregate of 97.8% was secured by Ishija Priyansha. Vidushi Jain secured 100% in Sanskrit while 3 students Sagar Rajhans, Vikas Kumar, Nikhil Kumar have secured 100% marks in Mathematics and 18 students Archita, Venkatesh, Vidushi, Aryan, Swarnadeep, Tanamay, Vaishnavi, Utkarsh, Aryansh,

Aditya, Sumit Raj, Pratham, Avika, Shreya, Palak, Sarth, Nupur Munda and Anushka have secured 100% marks in F.I.T.

The Ranadeb Chaudhuri Endowment for the highest marks in science was jointly shared by Kunal Kabra and Rachel Anamika Soreng. Both secured 94.6% While the Mira Chaudhuri Endowment for the highest aggregate in Commerce was secured by Hritik Raj, who also secured 94.6%. The Amala Goswami Endowment for the most outstanding student in the outgoing class X batch of AISSE-2019 is Sneha Das Chowdhury. She secured 95.8% in the Board Exam. An artist and an orator she has taken part in several essay writing competition, speech competition and won prizes at the school level. She has also won the school Rank-1 in the International English Olympiad and National Science Olympiad. Our heartiest congratulations to the special awardees.

In addition to commendable academic result, the students have been steadily competing and being selected into higher education professional colleges. Arnav Bansal after clearing NEET is presently a student of B M Patel Medical College Karnataka and Laxmi Kant Mahto is a student in RIMS, Ranchi. Silky Kumari after clearing JEE Advance and topping the successful girls candidate in Jharkhand is pursuing Engineering in IIT Mumbai and Rajshree Tejal Singh Munda is a student of IIT Roorkee. Tushar, Ashish Manoj, Rachel Anamika Soreng and Aparajita have cleared JEE Mains and are students of NIT Jamshedpur and BIT Mesra Ranchi. Sumit Kumar Sahu is studying engineering in IIIT, Allahabad while Aditya Paul is a student at Sikkim Manipal College of Engineering. Sanya Kumari is a student of Sinhgad College of Engineering Pune.

Ashish Singh, Aastha, Ritika Singh, Sneha and Debasmita are also pursuing engineering in KIIT, Bhubneshwar, Ria is at VIT Chennai whereas Yuvraj is studying at BIT Sindri, Kailash Nath, Ayush and Garima are pursuing engineering in CV Raman Bhubaneshwar, Aayush Naman is a proud student of SRM College of Engineering, Chennai.

Kshitiz is pursuing medicine in China and last but not the least, Manushree is a student of Doon Business School, Dehradun. Akansha Sharma is pursuing Commerce in the prestigious St. Xaviers College Kolkata.

Our ex-student Tanay Shankar of the AISSE - 2011 batch after completion his engineering from BITS Pilani and MBA from IIM Indore has qualified for UPSC 2018 with an All India Rank 136.

In association with academics our students Ayush Raj of class V and Aditya Prakash of class VIII have got Merit Certificates and cash prize of Rs. 1500/- in the Aryabhata Mathematics Competition organized by the DPS Society. In various Olympiads our students have been constantly doing well Kumari Shreya, Akansha Priya, Ananya Choudhary, Sarthak Patnaik, Shwarya, Shiya Agarwal, Ayush Jha, Harshit Kumar, Priyam Dutta, Venkatesh Modi, Harsh Ranjan, Abhishek Kumar, Mihir Raj, Bipul Kumar Aryan, Shilpi Nandini and Rohan Kr. Singh have received Rs. 1000/- cash Medals of distinction and certificate of zonal excellence. Ariba Ayraha VII-D has received a cash award of Rs. 5000/ and zonal gold medal in International Mathematics Olympiad, Sneha Sindhu of X-B and Md. Kamil Adab of V have received a cash prize of Rs. 5000/- and 2500/- in the zonal round in International English Olympiad Md. Kamil Adab has also secured a cash prize of Rs. 2500/- and the zonal silver medal in the International Science Olympiads.

By providing a conducive environment, Inter House activities are held which develops a child physically, morally, socially and hones his co-scholastic skills. Our students have participated in various Quiz competition and emerged winners Sushant Singh of IX B won the silver medal in the online PCRA Quiz, Shaurya Divya XII and Aditya Anshul have secured the 2nd position in the Amity University Quiz Competition.

Aditya Anshul of class XI and Vidushi Jain of class X were 1st runner up in the Cryptic Crossword at City Level and Monoshri Paul, Udisha Burnwal, Aashka Mishra of class VII were 1st runner up in the Seavers Eco Achievers Quiz. Swarup Mitra, Abhigyan Karn and Vaishnavi Jha of class X have won the 1st prize in quiz organization by CBI.

In the cultural scenario our students have won 3rd prize in creative Advertisement Competition at ILCC. The team comprised of Adiba,

Shrishti, Shreya, Rishabh, Abhinav and Moumita of class XII. The school bagged the 3rd prize in the Inter School group song and the 1st prize was bagged by Vedika of class VI in the Hindi and Kanishtha Banerjee in English Elocution Inter Elocution School Competition at ILCC, Ranchi. In the Inter School Poster making competition organized by CCL Hemant Raj of class XI and Laxmi Raj of class X won the 3rd & 1st prize simultaneously.

Our students have won several prizes in Inter School song, dance, speech, sit and draw competition, elocution to name a few. In Vivekutsav conducted by Vivekananda Vidya Mandir, DOX conducted by St. Xaviers Alumni and at Ramakrishna Mission Ashrama Annual Competition. A total of 55 students have won prizes.

In the 3rd State Level Philatelic Exhibition our students Surbhi Kumari of XI-B, Smridhi Kumari VII B and Divuanka Priya and Manav Shresht Singh of class 11 have secured the 1st and 2nd position in the "design a stamp" competition, whereas Shreya, Pahal and Ishita have secured the position 2nd in the Folk Dance Competition.

We have many plans for the future and many of them have been achieved. It's possible because of the continued effort of our teachers and students and the continued support & cooperation of your parents. We thank you parents that you stand by us in all our endeavours. We also hope that you parents and guardians look into your child's future and help inculcate values in them and also help them in getting better results.
